

Abstract Submission Guidelines

Submission link

All abstracts must be submitted online through the abstract submission platform. Abstracts that are sent via email will not be considered. Invited and non-invited speakers are asked to submit the abstract via the same link: <https://iserbiennialmeeting2026.org/program-2/submission/>

General Rules

- Abstracts must be submitted by the announced deadline. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered. The submission platform allows you to store your abstract as a draft to make changes. Please note that abstracts left in draft mode cannot be considered after the deadline of submission.
- **Each participant is allowed to present only ONE abstract** but can be listed as co-author of multiple abstracts.
- **Presenting authors of abstracts must be registered participants.** The presenting author is expected to attend the Meeting in person and present the abstract as a poster or oral presentation.
- We strongly encourage submission of abstracts showing original, unpublished results that were not be published or presented elsewhere prior to the ISER 2026 Meeting.
- The submitting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission to the Secretariat.
- The submitting author must declare if any conflict of interest exists, both in the submission and in the presentation slides.
- Early Career Researchers (ECR) may submit abstracts for oral or poster presentation. Early Career Researchers should refer to the ECR travel fellowship application section of the [website](#) for further information on the criteria for this financial support. Proof of ECR status should be uploaded during the abstract submission process.

Abstract Preparation

During submission, authors will be requested to provide the following:

- **Abstract title: limited to 20 words in Sentence case**
- Presentation type: oral or poster presentation
- Abstract topic: the full list of topics can be found [here](#).
- Contact details of the presenting author:
 - Full name as in the passport
 - Email address
 - Institution and affiliation
- Co-authors' details

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- Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- The abstract body must not exceed **300 words, including acknowledgements**.
- It is recommended to use only standard abbreviations and place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word appears the first time.
- It is recommended to use generic names of drugs and express numbers as numerals.
- Graphs and images are allowed. These may be resized to fit in with the final publication.

Consent

By submitting an abstract, the Abstract Submitter agrees to the following:

1. *I confirm that I previewed this abstract and that all information is correct. I accept that the content of this abstract cannot be modified or corrected after submission and I am aware that it will be published exactly as submitted.*
2. *I consent to the publication of this abstract on the ISER Meeting website, ISER online program, promotional materials, online eBook of abstracts.*
3. *I confirm that the contact details saved in this platform are those of the corresponding author, who will be notified about the status of the abstract. The corresponding author is responsible for informing the other authors about the status of the abstract.*
4. *I agree that all data provided may be used (saved, stored, processed, transmitted and deleted) in compliance with the [privacy policy](#) to provide the services described.*
5. *The Abstract Submitter warrants and represents that he/she is the sole owner or has the rights of all the information and content ("Content") provided to the XXVII Biennial Meeting of the International Society for Eye Research and K.I.T. Group (Hereafter: "The Organizers"). The publication of the abstract does not infringe any third-party rights including, but not limited to, intellectual property rights. The Abstract Submitter grants the Organizers a royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable nonexclusive license to use, reproduce, publish, translate, distribute, and display the content.*

Abstract Selection

The ISER 2026 Scientific Program Committee will review the abstracts and take the final decision on whether the abstract shall be presented as poster or oral presentation. The results will be communicated to the submitting author, who is responsible for informing the co-authors.

The Organizers reserve the right to remove from any publication abstracts which do not comply with the guidelines.
