ISER 2026 – POSTER PRESENTER GUIDELINES

Dear Colleague,

We would like to thank you for agreeing to present your poster during the XXVII Biennial Meeting of the International Society for Eye Research.

The poster area will be situated at Palacio de Congresos de Valencia at Level 0.

The size of your poster should not exceed 90cm in width and 150cm in height (**portrait format**).

Fixing materials will be available in the poster area.

Posters should be printed on paper (no textile), in portrait format. Posters printed on textiles cannot be accepted. Please bring your printed poster with you, as printing possibilities are not available on-site.

Text Layout

Give a short and comprehensive review of the basic items of your study. Divide your text into clearly delineated paragraphs and sections such as **Introduction or Aim, Materials and Methods, Result and Conclusions**. Remember that it is easier to read a paragraph of six lines or less. Your poster text should be enlarged so that it can be read at about one meter.

Illustration layout

Drawings, diagrams and pictures are helpful and often necessary to illustrate results and conclusions. Make sure that your illustrations are easy to understand. Do not overload charts or drawings with information.

Poster mounting and presentation time

Posters M01-M65 will be displayed on **Monday, August 24**.

Posters T01-T67 will be displayed on **Tuesday, August 25**.

Posters W01-W66 will be displayed on **Wednesday, August 26**.

Your exact poster number and session time will be confirmed to you via email.

Your paper poster should be mounted and displayed at the following times:

Posters should be mounted:

07:30 – 10:30

Posters should be presented:

17:30 – 19:00

Posters should be removed:

19:00 – 19:30

Posters not removed will be discarded and stored for pick up until the end of the meeting at the cloakroom. Posters and other materials will not be sent to you after the Meeting.



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Poster Sessions

All poster authors are kindly asked to be present at their poster board to give a brief presentation and to answer questions by participants during the poster sessions.

Please note the following time schedule for the poster sessions:

Monday, August 24 17:30 – 19:00

Tuesday, August 25 17:30 – 19:00

Wednesday, August 26 17:30 – 19:00

(Your poster session is on the day your poster is mounted)

Authors who agree to have their contact details made available to delegates are asked to include the information (e.g. e-mail address) on their posters.
